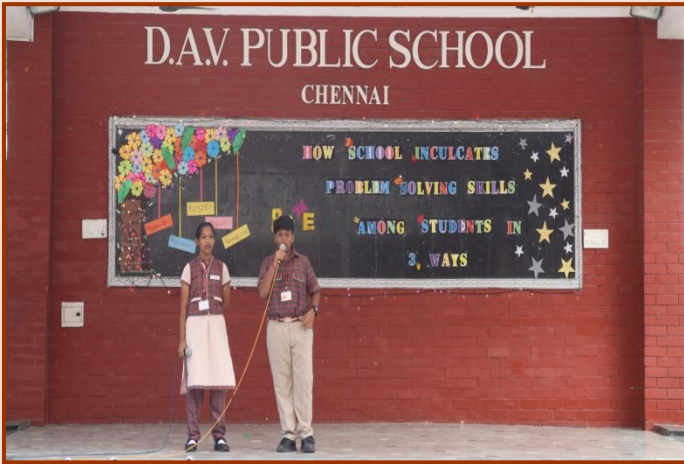

Last performance was a ‘Twilight Tango’ in which a group of Stage Rockers rocked the show with an elegant way of dancing with a good coordination.

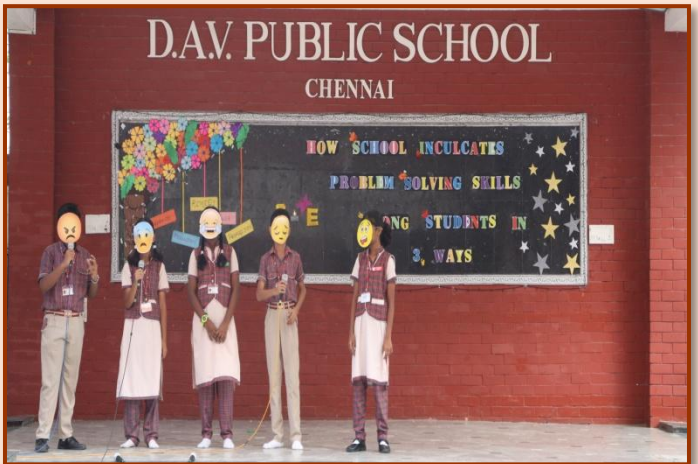
Next we had ‘Epilogue of Gratitude’ which was delivered by Angelin Mariam.

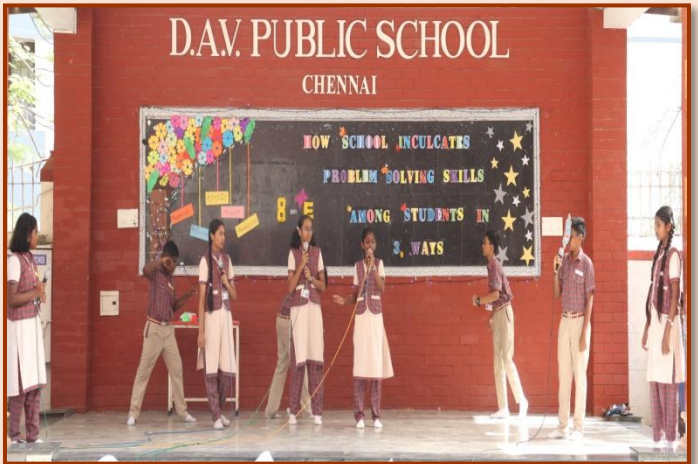
