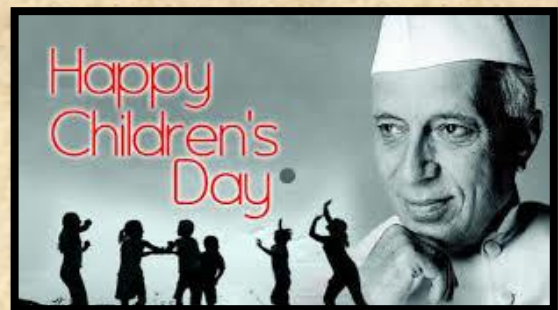

- **Vocabulary Development**

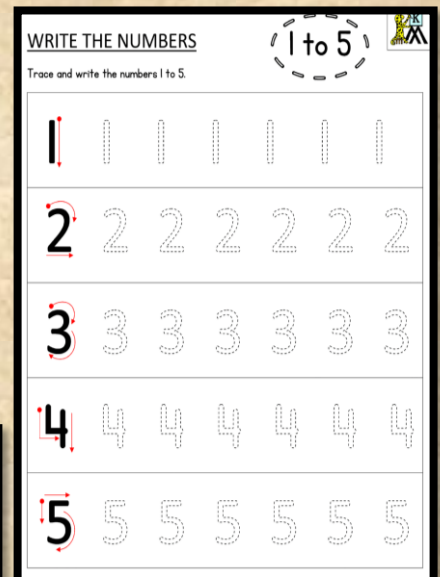
Children will be encouraged to give words beginning with a particular sound (a to z).

MATHS - NUMBER CONCEPTS

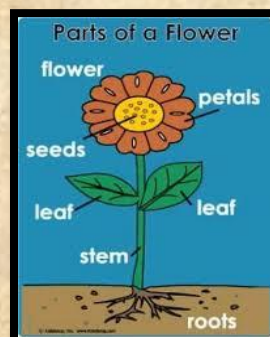
- Writing of numbers 1 to 5
