### ENGLISH

1. Make a Time Plan for your Summer Break . Highlight Pleasure Reading Time with your favourite colour.
2. On an A4 size sheet, make a Poster on Benefits of Reading.
3. Follow DEAR (Drop Everything And Read). All family members should decide upon a time when they drop everything else and read something. Read together daily. Get simple yet engaging storybooks, Children's Magazine or Newspaper and read every day.
4. Meet friends and cousins and hold storytelling sessions with them.
5. Make your own Comprehension Passages from the read stories. Make questions and write answers.(Work for at least 5 passages on A4 size sheets.)
6. Play Word Building Board Games.
7. Read all the lessons of My English Reader Book. Write meanings of new words in the book itself using a dictionary.
8. On A4 sheets develop your own QUIZ BANK for all the lessons of Periodic and Term Exam.
9. Learn the poems for Recitation and prepare for the First Periodic Test.
10. Work on your handwriting and make it better.

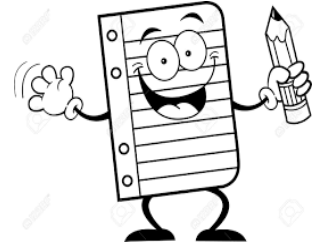
## SCIENCE

1. Read newspapers, magazines etc. and collect any five articles related to space and universe. Paste them on A4 size pastel sheets. (Maximum two articles on one sheet)
2. Read chapters 1 to 5, underline the difficult words and write their meanings in the book itself.
3. Learn and revise chapters 1 and 2 for first periodic test.



## SOCIAL STUDIES

1. Read about the ‘Seven Wonders of the World’ and prepare a creative, colourful advertisement (on a A-3 size sheet) to attract tourists to any one of them.
2. Visit any Historical Monument of Delhi and write a short note (around 60-70 words) on it in your S.ST note book.
3. Read all the chapters and write the meanings of difficult words in the book itself.
4. Revise the chapters done in the class.
5. Practice the maps done in the class.



## MATHEMATICS

1. Make a Math journal of the situations in which you used Mathematics in your holidays. For eg- the calculations you made when you bought something or while deciding which game or toy to buy etc. (**Math journals**, are books in which students record their **math** work and thinking).  
Three different types of prompts are recommended:
  - **Attitudes**: Write about your personal thoughts and feelings about math.
  - **Learning**: Write about what you’ve learned and reflect on what you know (and don’t know).
  - **Process**: Explain how to solve problems or discuss a particular skill or strategy.
2. Make a factor tree and a Factor rainbow of any number using pastel sheet ,colours or any other material of your choice
3. Explore divisibility rules and note down in a ruled sheet
4. Make any one board game on any mathematical concept
5. Prepare a question bank having 10 questions(MCQ) on the topics of periodic test 1 on A4 sheets
