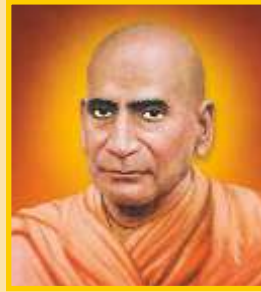

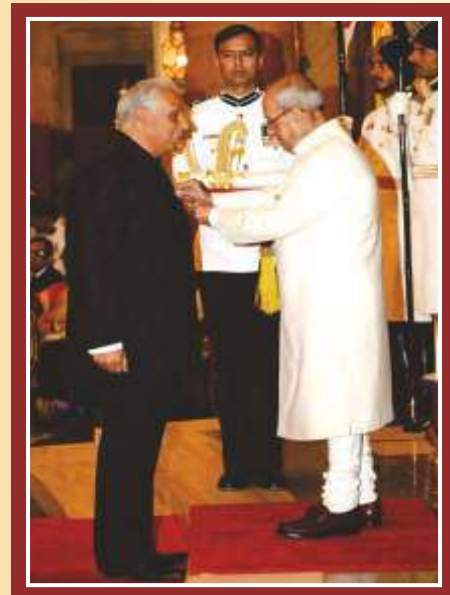

## The DAV Movement Arya Samaj and DAV Movement

On Swami Dayanand Saraswati's demise in 1883, a group of socially-oriented people, when met to mourn his death, decided to raise a memorial that would be a befitting tribute to his great ideals. They formed the Dayanand Anglo - Vedic (DAV) College Trust and Management Society, which was registered in 1885. This was the beginning of a great movement, which is now popularly known as the DAV Movement. The Society established its first institution DAV School at Lahore on 1st June 1886, with Lala Hansraj (later known as Mahatma Hansraj) as Headmaster (honorary).

The aim of the DAV institutions is to impart education to children in such a way that it helps them to imbibe a sense of deep patriotism and that of pride in their ancient culture and civilization and instill in them a disciplined outlook on the pursuit of knowledge. These institutions aim at creating an environment truly conducive to the development of the child mentally, physically and spiritually.

The DAV College Trust and Management Society is already more than a hundred and thirty five years old. This is now the largest non-government educational organisation in India. It broadly covers the entire spectrum of the educational activities in the country. The Society is running more than 950 educational institutions, which include, in addition to public schools (spread all over the country and abroad), colleges of arts, science, education, commerce and law, polytechnic, an ayurvedic college, a dental college, a pharmacy and Vedic research institutes.

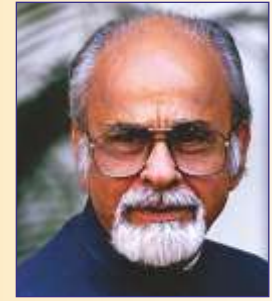

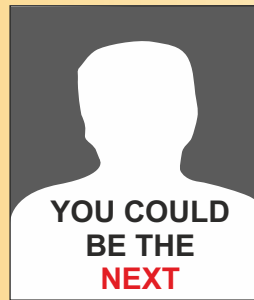

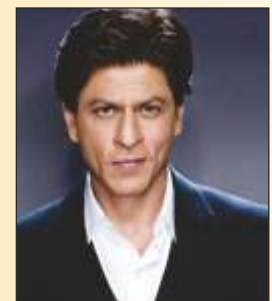

## INTRODUCTION

Dayanand Anglo-Vedic (DAV) College Trust and Management Society was registered in 1885 after the demise of Swami Dayanand Saraswati in 1883. The society established its first institution DAV School at Lahore on 1st June 1886, with Lala Hansraj (later known as Mahatma Hansraj as headmaster (honorary).

The aim of the DAV Institutions is to impart education to children in such a way that it helps them to imbibe a sense of deep patriotism and that of pride in their ancient culture and civilization. More than a hundred and thirty five years old, this institution is now the largest non-government educational organisation in India and abroad having colleges of arts, science, education, commerce and law, polytechnic, an ayurvedic college, a dental college, a pharmacy and Vedic research institutes.

DAV CMC runs and manages over 950 institutions comprising of public schools, grants-in-aid schools, colleges, institutes of professional education, research institutions and universities and trusted by both, public as well as private sector. It also discharges its social responsibility by running ashrams and orphanages for the underprivileged and destitute children and women.

The DAV College Managing Committee (DAV CMC) is managed by a galaxy of luminaries from diverse fields who are committed to the philosophy of Arya Samaj and ideals of Swami Dayanand Saraswati.

## THE SCHOOL (ABODE OF LEARNING)

DAV Model School KSTP Asansol is a CBSE Affiliated Co-Educational English medium Senior Secondary school under the aegis of DAV College Managing Committee, New Delhi which had its inception on 4th of August, 2017. The School Campus is set in two acres of land in Kalyanpur Satellite Township having a four storied building and a new building which is under construction. The school treasures more than 2000 brimming students. The instructional materials and textbooks of all classes till standard VIII are designed by DAV Centre of Academic Excellence, New Delhi and from standard IX onwards NCERT textbooks are followed.

The School has Smart Classrooms, well equipped Computer laboratory, Science laboratory, an enriched Library to satiate the thirst of inquisitive minds and a vast playground to facilitate children to play outdoors. The school campus is aided by CCTV surveillance, Public Address system and Fire Fighting System to look into the safety and security of students. It has successfully completed 6 years and has added some feathers of achievement to its crown. Now the school has received Affiliation for its Senior Secondary level. ## HOUSING SYSTEM

Inter House activities and competitions are held during the CCA periods round the year to foster leadership qualities and team spirit as well as to provide a platform to bring out from the student.

## SPORTS

The students of the school are provided a platform to groom their sporting talent by DAV National Sports, recognized by SGFI and CBSE zonal sports which instill qualities like leadership, discipline, honesty and team spirit.

## COMPOSITE LABORATORY AND LIBRARY

Laboratories are the most important infrastructure of an educational institution. DAV Model School, KSTP, Asansol has well equipped laboratories for Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Computer separately to do practical experiments and gather knowledge. It provides an open environment for students to experiment and do research work under the professional guidance and assistance of competent faculty members. The School Library has a good collection of books of various discipline and genres and informative materials, which are beneficial and enriching for both students and teachers of the school.

## INTER HOUSE COMPETITIONS

Inter House competitions are organized periodically in Dance, Arts, Elocution, Recitation, Music and other extra-curriculum activities which inculcate the spirit of healthy competition among students and give them the opportunity to enhance and exhibit their skills in their fields of interest.

## CELEBRATIONS AND SOCIAL CAUSE

## REGARDING SCHOOL EXAMINATIONS.

Preparatory Classes: As per CBSE rules there is no examination for these classes, however they are assessed by three Evaluations:

**Evaluation I: April to July**

**Evaluation II: August to September**

Evaluation III: December to March.

The performance of the Child is evaluated through Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) and through Co-curricular activities. Emphasis is given on activity based teaching-learning process.

The Academic Session is divided into two terms for rest other classes.

**Term I: April to September**

**Term II: October to March**

Term I comprises of Pre- Mid Term Examination and Mid Term/ Half Yearly Examination. Term II comprises of Post- Mid Term Examination and Annual Examination. Pre-Mid Term and Post-Mid Term comprises of Periodic Test, Note Book Submission and Subject Enrichment Activities from Std-III the students are assessed as per CBSE and DAV CMC norms.

## COMPETITION, PARTICIPATION AND ACHIEVEMENTS

Inter house competitions are organised periodically in Dance, Arts, Education, Recitation, Music and other extracurricular activities and our students are motivated to participate in competitions and Olympiads organised by CBSE Sahodaya Complex, CBSE, SOF, DAV CMC and other Government bodies like VVM, NTSE etc, which inculcate the spirit of healthy competition among students and give them the opportunity to enhance and exhibit their skills in their fields of interest.

"All our dreams can come true if we have courage to pursue them." - Keeping it in mind we strive to groom the students wholly beside academic excellence and encourage them to embrace success in different fields. Some of our students excelled in different categories of co-curricular activities in recent past.

Under the aegis of District Council for School Games and Sports, Paschim Barddhaman and The Director of School Education Govt. Of West Bengal, District Level School Basketball Competition, District Level Yogasana Competition and District level Chess Championship were conducted. Three students in Chess and one student in Basketball got selected for State level and one student qualified in Yogasana for District Level. In another Chess competition organized by All Bengal Chess League 2023, four of our students bagged the 1<sup>st</sup> prize (under 14 age group), 2nd prize (under 12 age group), 3rd prize (under 8 age group) and 4th prize (under 14 age group). One of our students has bagged the first prize in National Sports Day Chess Championship organised by SAIL, ISP, Burnpur. Moreover two of our teams qualified for District Level and got nominated for State Level in 31<sup>st</sup> National Children's Science Congress. Not only that one of our students is taking part in All India Radio (Prasar Bharti) as a child artist in singing. Thus we are devoting ourselves in the holistic development of each student.

## MY UNIFORM

DAV College Managing Committee, New Delhi has introduced a common uniform along with shoes and socks as an identity among the students of all DAV Schools across the country. It instills unity, belongingness, oneness and shows that you are a part of the organization. School uniform seems to maintain a distinctive image of the school where every student must report to school in neat and clean uniform regularly.

Note: (i) A sample of the regular uniform shall be displayed on the notice board. ii) House uniform to be worn on every Friday from Std III onwards with white shoes and white socks. The uniform shall be displayed on the notice board.

## ADMISSION PROCEDURE

### Eligibility

The age requirement as on 1st April of the year of admission.

Nursery : 3+ years to 4 years

Class LKG : 4+ years to 5 years

Class UKG : 5+ years to 6 years

## REGISTRATION

(i) The Registration form and Prospectus will be available from the School office. (ii) The dully filled in form along with the required documents must be submitted in the School office by the given stipulated date. (iii) The registered candidate will be called for test/interview.

Registration fee is not refundable and registration is no guarantee for admission.

## TEST/INTERVIEW

- ❖ Admission will be made strictly on the basis of merit.
- ❖ Admission is on the basis of written test and an interview.
- ❖ There is no written test for admission to Preparatory Classes. However, the candidate has to appear for an interactive session along with parents.
- ❖ Students offered admission must complete the admission formalities within the stipulated date or the offer will stand cancelled.

## PAYMENT OF FEES

- All fees payments have to be made in advance only through Online Fee Portal within 20th day of each month.
- Monthly fees must be paid in advance for each month or together for a number of months.
- No fee is refundable (Except Refundable Security) once admission process has completed.
- If any student fails to deposit the fees for three consecutive months without any intimation to the school his/her name shall be struck off from the school register and the student will be allowed to rejoin only with the written permission from the head of the school and after the payment of rupees Rs. 1500/- along with the up to date fees and fine.
