- Please note that our school is a centre for the CBSE Board Examinations and hence the pattern of sale of textbooks for classes Jr. K.G. to VIII has been changed, keeping everybody's convenience in mind.
- You are requested to submit for Std. VII, cheque for an amount of Rs. 1111.00 with Sanskrit books/ Rs. 1139.00 with Marathi books drawn in favour of <u>D.A.V. Public School, New Panvel –a Unit of DAV College Trust and</u> <u>Management Society</u>. Name of the student, class, section and contact number must be written behind the cheque. Please give the cheque to the class teacher before 9<sup>th</sup> March 2018 between 7.30 am to 9.00 am. The receipt for the same may be collected during the Open House from the class teacher. Books will be issued on 26.03.2018 for Std. VII between 2.30 pm. to 4.30 pm., on producing the receipt.
- Fee hike of 15% will be applicable w.e.f. April 2018. The hike is approved by the PTA as per the norms.
- Before purchasing School Uniform you are requested to note that the pattern of school uniform changes in Std. I, Std. VI and Std. VIII and thus make your purchases accordingly. So also note that the approved pattern of uniform, school logo and belt are available with Ideal Uniforms, New Panvel. However you are free to purchase the uniform from a vendor of your choice, but ensure that the pattern, logo and belt are as approved by the school.
- Students are expected to come in proper school uniform from the first day of the reopening of school in April 2018.
- Parents who wish to apply for Transfer Certificate of their ward are requested to submit the application before 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018 to avoid payment of fees for the month of April.
